This year, the statutory end of Key Stage 1 SATs will be going ahead as they last did two years ago. We will commence the Year 2 SATs in school the week beginning the 16th May and will do them over the last two weeks of the half term. We will ensure that the children are comfortable and supported during this time, with plenty of brain breaks. Year 2s will be completing both a maths paper and a reading comprehension.
