



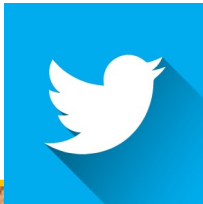
Skylarks News

A reminder that children can change their books on any day. **Please ensure that your child has their planner in school every day as well.**

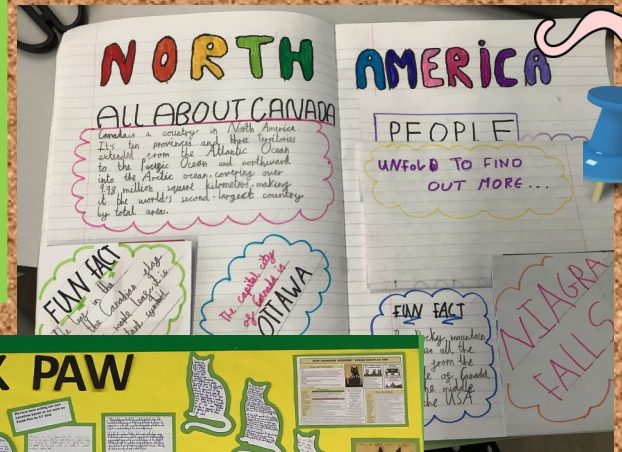
