We are also having a whole school focus on kindness with the introduction of "a summer of kindness" Children from each class will be part of a kindness team, encouraging others to treat each other with kindness and respect. We have play leaders who encourage and lead active games at play time which support our PE Values and last term the Sports service also worked with Year One children to help them to learn new playground games. This term we will be enjoying a skipping workshop to support the children further with their play and encourage happy active playtimes.
