Welcome to Class 6 at Havannah First School.

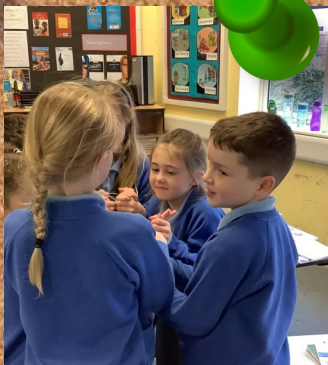
