


ENGLISH

Explanation

During this topic, we will use Talk for Writing to focus on reading and writing explanations, identifying and then using the structural and grammatical conventions, such as the use of the third person, conjunctions and the use of facts instead of opinions.

Key Stories

During this topic we will be focusing on our next key story for this year. We will be reading and discussing the book, using Talk for Writing to pick out features and innovate our own key story. We will also be working on writing tasks linked to the text including using fronted adverbials with commas to improve our sentence structure, expanded noun phrases for character descriptions and inverted commas while writing conversations between the characters in our new, invented text.

Geography


Rainforests



In Geography this half term, we will be learning about where rainforests are in the world and how they are structured. We will also be looking at the role of rainforests within climate change and the impact of rainforest destruction.

SCIENCE

Sound



In Science this half term, we will be looking at identifying how sounds are made, associating them with vibrations, looking at how sound travels and finding patterns between the pitch of a sound and features of the object that produced it.
