ENGLISH



Fiction - Traditional Tales

Using Jack and the Beanstalk as our main text, children will be able to retell their own version of a traditional tale. They will be able to identify openings and endings e.g. A long time ago in a dark forest etc. and identify how formulaic sentences are used e.g. there was once a...

Children will then write their own version of a traditional tale.

GEOGRAPHY

Our Geography topic this half term is 'Which country do we live in?' We will:

- *Locate on a map the four countries of the United Kingdom.
- *Identify the four capital cities and surrounding seas of the United Kingdom.
- *Explain the differences between human and physical features.
- *Describe the human and physical features of one of the UK's capital cities



Year 1 - Spring 1

MATHS

This half term we will be learning all about place value to 20 and then addition and subtraction within 20. Children will learn to:

- ♣ Count to and across 20, forwards and backwards, beginning with 0 or 1, or from any given number
- ♣ Identify one more and one less than a number to 20.
- ♣ Identify and represent numbers using objects and pictorial representations including the number line, and use the language of: equal to, more than, less than (fewer), most, least.
- A Read and write numbers from 1 to 20 in numerals and words.
- ♣ Read, write and interpret mathematical statements involving addition (+), subtraction (-) and equals (=) signs
- * Represent and use number bonds and related subtraction facts within 20
- ♣ Add and subtract one-digit and two-digit numbers to 20, including zero

SCIENCE

In Science lessons, we will investigate, 'Why is it always cold in winter?'
We will learn about Seasonal change, carry out observations in our school grounds and local area and carry out investigations to see how animals stay warm in the winter!



P.E.

In our PE lessons this half term we are developing our gymnastics skills. In our other sessions, with NUF, we will be developing our throwing and catching skills.

RE

In RE lessons, we will learn about the Bible and why the Bible is so important to Christians.

PSHE

Our topic in PSHE lessons this half term is 'Dreams and Goals.' We will share our successes and enjoy finding out about each other's interests and goals.
