ENGLISH



Fiction - Traditional Tales

Using Jack and the Beanstalk as our main text, children will be able to retell their own version of a traditional tale.

They will be able to identify openings and endings e.g. A long time ago in a dark forest etc. and identify how formulaic sentences are used e.g. there was once a...

Children will then write their own version of a traditional tale.

Non-Fiction - Information Texts

We will then write information texts about Giants, Trolls and other fantasy creatures!

GEOGRAPHY

In Geography lessons, we will:

- use simple fieldwork and observational skills to study the geography of our school and its grounds.
- Record the daily weather in our area.
- Start to identify seasonal and daily weather patterns in the United Kingdom.





Year 1 - Spring 1

MATHS

This half term we will be learning all about place value to 20 and then addition and subtraction within 20.

Children will learn to:

- ♣ Count to and across 20, forwards and backwards, beginning with 0 or 1, or from any given number
- ♣ Identify one more and one less than a number to 20.
- * Identify and represent numbers using objects and pictorial representations including the number line, and use the language of: equal to, more than, less than (fewer), most, least.
- * Read and write numbers from 1 to 20 in numerals and words
- ♣ Read, write and interpret mathematical statements involving addition (+), subtraction (-) and equals (=) signs
- * Represent and use number bonds and related subtraction facts within 20
- Add and subtract one-digit and two-digit numbers to 20, including zero.

SCIENCE

In Science lessons, we will investigate, 'Why is it always cold in winter?' We will learn about Seasonal change, carry out observations in our school grounds and local area and carry out investigations to see how animals stay warm in the winter!

P.E.

In our PE lessons this half term we are developing our gymnastics skills. In our other sessions, with NUF, we will be developing our throwing and catching skills.

RE

In RE lessons, we will learn about the Bible and why the Bible is so important to Christians.

PSHE

We will continue with our work on the Zones of Regulation and think about our families and relationships.

MUSIC

Children will develop skills in listening and appraising and composition this half term.

COMPUTING

Children will be introduced to algorithms and will start to learn how simple algorithms are used.

<u>Art</u>

Children will learn and develop their skills in: design, drawing, craft, painting and art appreciation.
