| River Zambezi | The fourth-longest river in Africa, the longest east-flowing river in Africa and the largest flowing into the Indian Ocean from Africa; it passes through six countries, one of which is Zambia. |
| Mugarameno | Name of a small village in Zambia. |
| wild animals | Animals that live in the area that surround the village and can pose danger to the people and their homes. |
| daily life | How people, including children, spend their time in the village. |
| village | A small settlement usually found in a rural setting. |
