Africa	The world's second-largest and second-most populous continent.
Zambia	Zambia, in southern Africa, is a landlocked country of rugged terrain and diverse wildlife, with many parks and safari areas.
River Zambezi	The fourth-longest river in Africa, the longest east-flowing river in Africa and the largest flowing into the Indian Ocean from Africa; it passes through six countries, one of which is Zambia.
Mugarameno	Name of a small village in Zambia.
wild animals	Animals that live in the area that surround the village and can pose danger to the people and their homes.
daily life	How people, including children, spend their time in the village.
village	A small settlement usually found in a rural setting.
