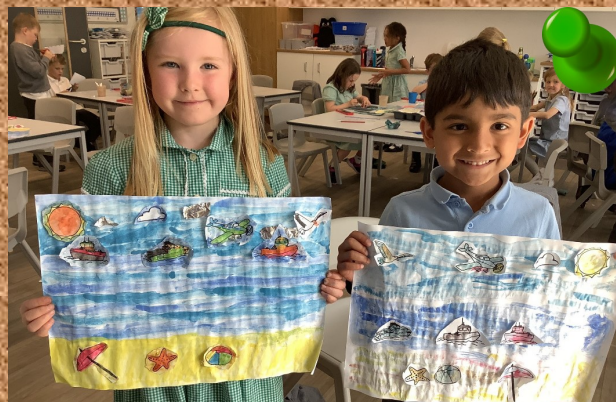
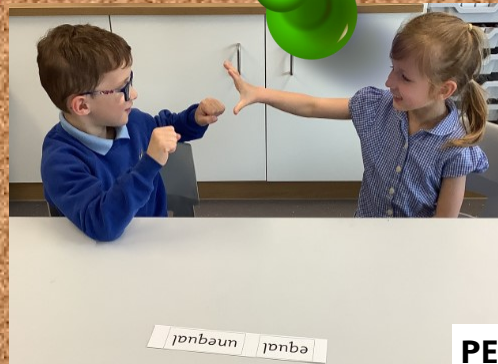
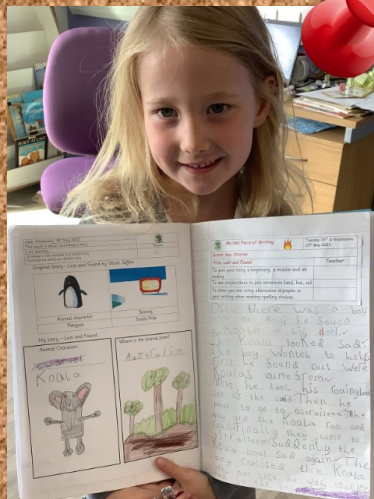




Class 2 News

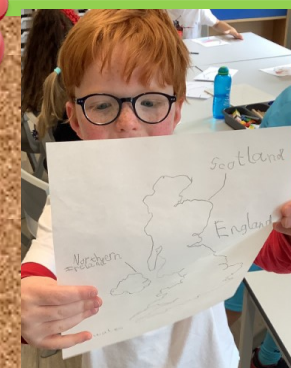
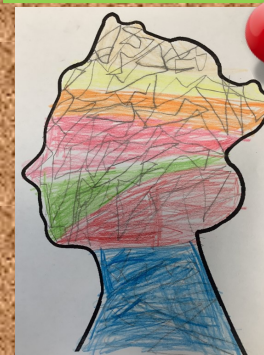
PE
