Uniform

Please remember that the old blue uniform can be worn until it is worn out! There is no requirement for you to purchase a whole new uniform. If you are buying the new items, they are as below:

General uniform

Mid grey sweatshirt or cardigan (logo optional from Tots to Teams)

Y4 children can wear leavers' hoodies for the summer term

White polo shirt (logo optional from Tots to Teams)

Dark grey pinafore, dress, trousers or shorts

Dark green gingham dress

PE:

Dark green t shirt (logo optional from Tots to Teams)

Black shorts, leggings or joggers

Dark green hoodie for outdoor lessons and forest school activities (logo optional from Tots to Teams)

Dark green drawstring bag (logo optional)

Coats:

Children can wear any coat to school and there are two different dark green coats with the logo available from Tots to Teams.



Bags:

Children can use any bag which is suitable and can be hung easily on a peg.

Green back-pack/rucksack will be available in two sizes, badged and in dark green from Tots to Teams. Children can carry them easily if walking, scooting or cycling and they can put their water bottle upright in the exterior pocket.

Shoes:

Shoes should be black, hard wearing, appropriate for outdoor and adventurous play and should be closed in around the toes and back of the foot. For safety reasons, we advise against strappy sandals, crocs, jellies, fashion boots and canvas shoes.

Bus for Y4 Transport for the Summer Term

Reminder for parents and carers of Y4 children using the bus:

- The bus will be departing each day from the car park at Gosforth East Middle School at 8.30am and will depart from the Havannah site at 3.30pm to arrive back at GEMS at approximately 3.45pm.
- GEMS do not allow parents and carers to drive into the carpark at these times, please park off site if you are arriving by car.
- You will need to accompany your children to the bus and then pick them up from the coach at the of the day.
- The bus will not be able to wait at GEMS for families who are running late.
- There will be a member of our staff on the bus to keep everyone safe, please talk to your children and reinforce the message of staying in their seat and wearing a seatbelt.
