




Squirrels Spring Term 2

Meanings within Easter

MUSIC

Developing Notation Skills and Pocket Trumpets

The Body

We will revisit previously learnt skills and vocabulary and use these to extend our learning of names of body parts in Spanish.

We will learn that fruits & vegetables grow in different countries based on their climates & understand that 'seasonal' fruits & vegetables are those that grow in a given season. We will also design our own tart recipe using seasonal ingredients and understand the basic rules of food hygiene.
