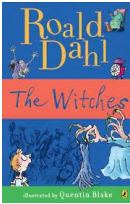




Year 4 - Summer Term 2



ENGLISH

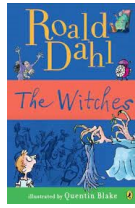
INFORMATION TEXTS

Using the Talk for Writing model, we will be writing information texts about our visit to Robin

Wood initially. We will be looking closely at the features and purpose of information texts and using these within our writing.

PLAYSCRIPTS

We will be looking closely at the features of a play script, the differences between play scripts and narratives and acting out a short section of a play script. We will then use this knowledge to write our own play scripts.



HISTORY

The Tudors



In History this half term, we will be learning about the changing power of monarchs during Tudor times. We will contrast and compare the monarchs from Tudor times with the monarchs of today and discuss the advantages and disadvantages associated with each period of monarchy.

COMPUTING

Micro Bits and Scratch

In Computing this half term, Mr Hughes from GEM Education will be working with us on Micro Bits. We will also be using the Scratch software to code sequences.



SCIENCE

Living Things and their Habitats



In Science, we will be extending our learning of living things and their habitats to look closer at classification. We will be exploring how living things can be classified and recognise that they can be grouped in a variety of ways. We will ask relevant scientific questions and gather and record our findings to support our classifications.

PE

Tennis and Athletics



In PE this half term, we will be working outdoors (when the weather allows) to develop our skills for these sports. Teamwork, communication and cooperation will be themes running throughout the lessons alongside the skill development.

RE

Religions in the Local Community

In RE this half term, we will learn about religion in our local area by collecting and interpreting research from a range of sources. We will also develop our understanding of the ways in which individuals express their religious identity.

MUSIC

Purpose, Identity and Expression in Music

In Music this half term, we will be exploring how music connects us with the environment. We will be following the Charanga scheme.

PHSE

Economic Wellbeing

In PHSE this half term, we will be exploring how to earn money and keep it safe. We will also be looking into different careers and the stereotypes that often surround them.

SPANISH

Sports and Hobbies

In Spanish, we will learn the words for various sports and hobbies. We will also be able to describe our own hobbies and also talk about some of the activities we take part in to keep ourselves healthy.

DT

Adapting a Recipe/Torches

We will be following a recipe, trying recipes and then adapting a recipe by adding our own ingredients to it.

We will also be identifying electrical products, making a working switch, identifying features of torches and creating designs which follow a specific brief.
