









## Long Term Plan for Music

### Havannah First School Music Units and Coverage

**Musical Spotlight:** There is one Musical Spotlight to each unit In Key Stage 1 and 2. This by no means indicates that there is only one musical aspect or concept being considered and developed – it just allows one chosen musical element, aspect or skill to come to the fore for contemplation, discussion and development, for the duration of that unit.

**Social Theme Question:** In each unit, children are asked a question, intended as an entry point for exploring one of six broad Social Themes. These six themes are overlapping. The exploration of each theme accompanies them on their musical journey throughout the Charanga Scheme, and hopefully beyond! As the learners grow, the questions and entry points for the Social Themes evolve. All the while, they are encouraged to be responsible and kind citizens of the world and constructive but critical thinkers. The unit question are discussed throughout each unit up to and including the final unit performance.

### Additional Music opportunities

- Alongside our curriculum provision for music, children in Year 2 to Year 4 are also the opportunity to participate in additional group music tuition. They are offered the opportunity to learn a musical instrument with peripatetic teachers, organised by Music Partnership North. This includes: keyboard, violin and guitar. The lessons last 30 minutes across 10 weeks.
- Additional extra-curricular opportunities are offered in music, such as the key stage 2 choir and Gosforth Voices. Both groups provide the opportunity for children to perform to a wider audience both in school and at events in the local community.
