Dear Parents and Carers,

Welcome back to Bramble Class! We hope you all had a lovely holiday and are looking forward to another wonderful half term in Year 2! We have lots of fabulous learning planned for the next few weeks and our topic overview, which we send to you, details the objectives we will be covering. We are also sending out the Knowledge Organisers which the children use in Geography and Science. These will give you specific information about the exact knowledge that children need to know and remember. The children have these Knowledge Organisers in their books and they fill them in as they go along, ensuring that they can recall knowledge learnt. We really hope that you find these a useful tool for enabling you to discuss learning with your children and to reinforce the facts that the children need to know (the 'sticky' knowledge). Please ask us if you have any further questions about this.

We have a really busy half term planned, and for the last two weeks, we will be completing our SATS assessments in Maths and Reading. We will be setting homework tasks which will support the children's learning and will revisit some of the concepts previously taught.

We have planned a school trip for Thursday 15th June after half term. This will be to the Centre for Life and more details about this will follow. We will be consolidating our learning about the continents and oceans through a story telling workshop, as well as exploring the different science learning opportunities that they have there.





Organisation of Belongings:

This term is particularly important as the children start preparing for moving up into Key Stage 2. We are reminding children to change their reading books regularly and to hand their homework to us on the Monday after it is set.
