In your child's new reading record, you will find useful information including phonics and a list of the new common exception words which children need to learn how to read and spell by the end of Year 1, this is something that you can support your child with throughout the year.

Our PE this half term will be taught by Mr Richardson and will be focused on using space which is part of our fundamental movement and team games unit. The children will also be developing their balance bike skills using some of our new balance bikes in the outdoor area.
