

## P.S.E.D

We will be learning about being healthy. We will be exploring how we can keep our bodies healthy and understand how moving and resting are good for our bodies. We will be learning about foods which are healthy and not so healthy so that we can make healthy eating choices.

We will also be learning about the importance of oral hygiene and getting lots of sleep!

## Communication and Language

We will be articulating our ideas and thoughts into well-formed sentences and talking about similarities and differences between things in the past and now.

We will be using language to imagine and recreate roles in our 'pet shop' and 'vets' role play area.

## Physical Development

We will develop our fine motor skills with our finger challenges and practice forming our letters correctly.

In PE, we will be developing our negotiating space skills within our fundamental movement unit. We will also be developing our dance skills this half term. We will be moving to music in an open space, copying and repeating actions as well as joining movements together.

## Literacy

We will be acting out the story 'We're going on an egg hunt', as well as labelling a story map.

We will also read non-fiction texts about how to look after your pet.

We will be applying our phase 2 and 3 phonic knowledge to write labels and captions linked to the stories we are reading in class.

We will continue to apply our growing phonic knowledge to read words and sentences.



## EYFS Spring Term 2 Real Life Superheroes and Amazing Animals.



### Understanding the World

We will be learning about how different people help us in our community.

We will be talking about signs of new life on a farm during spring time.

We will be using Google Earth to compare the difference between the town where we live and life in other countries.

We will be learning about Easter and how this festival is celebrated.

### Expressive Arts and Design

We will be using junk-modelling materials to make different styles of houses from other parts of the world.

We will be listening and responding to different types of music.

We will be using natural objects to create our own art work, linked to the artist 'Andy Goldsworthy'.

We will be printing patterns during our Easter craft activities.

### Mathematics

We will be exploring the composition of and representation of numbers 9 and 10, developing the understanding that that all numbers are made up of smaller numbers. We will also continue our work on combining 2 groups.

We will be comparing numbers within 10 using key vocabulary more than and fewer than. We will also be exploring number bonds to 10 using real objects in different contexts.

We will be exploring and manipulating 3D shapes, exploring more complex patterns and looking at length and height.
