Thank you for your interest in this post at Havannah First School.

We are a first school situated in Newcastle Great Park and part of the Gosforth Schools' Trust. Following our relocation from the Broadway East First School site in 2022, we are now in a state of the art, brand new school building on a site with exciting outdoor learning opportunities. We are gradually expanding to meet the needs of the growing community in this part of the city and hope to be at capacity as a three-form entry first school in the next few years. The school is adjacent to the Havannah Nature Reserve and on the North West part of the Great Park. The age range of our children is 4-9 years, Reception to Year 4. We are currently a two-form entry first school with 10 classes and approximately 300 children on roll. In our team, we have 8 full time teachers, 3 part-time teachers and 13 non-teaching members of staff as well as midday staff.

We are looking for a Teaching Assistant to support teaching and learning in KS2. This will be a very varied role, with some class based support and some intervention for children with SEN, including small group work and 1 to 1 support. Everyone in our staff team is flexible, approachable and committed to working towards getting the very best for our children. You must be able to demonstrate that you are an excellent team player with effective communication skills and relevant experience. Our children are brilliant and enthusiastic learners and we have strong support from our families. We are a No Outsiders School and we all work together towards giving everyone a valued part in increasing opportunities for everyone in the school family.
