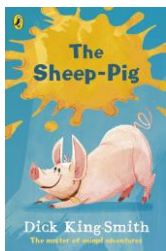


## ENGLISH

#### Key Stories

### Geography

#### The United Kingdom



In Geography this half term, we will be learning about the countries that make up the UK, comparing and contrasting them, examining the impact that humans have had on the landscape and looking at the industries and energy sources found in our country.

## SCIENCE

### Plants



In Science this half term, we will be learning about plants. The focus will be on the parts of plants and their functions as well as what is needed in order for them to thrive. We will also investigate how water is transported around the plant and the role of a flower in pollination and fertilization. Through this, the children will also develop their investigation skills.

## MATHS

### Place Value

- Represent and partition hundreds, tens and ones using a range of resources.
- Find 1, 10 and 100 more or less than.
- Explore the number line to 1000.
- Compare and order numbers and objects.
- Count in 50s.

### Addition and Subtraction

- Add and subtract 1s, 10s and 100s.
- Add up to two 3-digit numbers with and without exchanges.
- Subtract two 3-digit numbers with and without exchanges.
- Use efficient subtraction strategies.
- Spot patterns in calculations.
- Estimate and check answers and strategies.

In P.E. this half term, we will be working outdoors and developing our teamwork and resilience by completing a range of outdoor activities such as orienteering with peers.
