

ENGLISH

Narrative Poetry



During this topic, the children will reading an example of narrative poetry, identifying the use of alliteration, onomatopoeia, rhythm, repetition and use of the senses.

Fables



During this topic, the children will read a range of fables and identify their features including the moral message that the fable teaches the reader. They will use this knowledge to plan and write their own version of a fable that they have read.

Instructions



During this topic, the children will read and follow a range of sets of instructions. After identifying the features, they will use this knowledge to write their own instructions for specific tasks using their learning in their own writing.
